 - Public Safety and Community Care (Andrea Porto)
 - Sgt Holloway - Atlanta Police Department (APD).
 1. Sgt. Williams will be taking Sgt. Holloway's position at APT's monthly community meeting. Sgt. Williams can be contacted at sdwilliams@atlantaga.gov
 2. Sgt. Holloway was asked to provide an estimate of how many times Atlanta Police Department refers cases to Policing Alternatives & Diversion (PAD). APD does not record or track this.

 - Land Use and Code Enforcement (Jarred Bone)
 - 778 Tift Ave lot split

1. Teo Sagisman originally presented a proposal to Adair Park Today in 2019 to rezone 778 Tift Ave. Received approval letter at that time and was rezoned to r4b, which allows for splitting a lot. The project was put on pause during the COVID-19 pandemic. The City asked Sagisman to inform the community that he will be restarting the project plans and splitting the lot.

- Housing Fund Committee (Amanda Newsom)
 - \$500 was distributed in November for critical home repairs.
 - Roughly \$6,500 was distributed to 12 neighbors (15 grants) in 2024.
- Parks and Public Spaces (Alex D'Antoni)
 - January 25th deadline to apply for grant from Cherokee Garden Club.
 - Congratulations to committee member, Martha, who graduated from Park Pride's Parks Stewardship Academy. As a result, will have access to apply to a park activation grant.
- Historic Preservation (Jeannie Mills)
- Transportation (Matthew Garbett)
 - ATLDOT will have preliminary designs for "Safe Routes to School" in January 2025. The City Council has pledged \$125,000 in support.
- Porches and Pies / Events (Kimberly Johnson)
 - Wrapping up a P&P grant report to fulfill the grant obligations.

4. President's Report

- The City Council voted unanimously to stop a rezoning proposal that would allow Data Centers to inhabit West End Production Park.
